## ***Join the London Citizens Summer Academy***

**London Citizens** is the capital's largest and most diverse community alliance. Through its broad network of community leaders and local civil society institutions it brings the concerns of London's most marginalised communities to the attention of powerful institutions and individuals. **London Citizens'** campaigns have created real change in many of the capital's most deprived neighbourhoods.

**We are looking for talented men and women**, usually in their final year of undergraduate, or finishing off their Masters. You need to be interested in people, relational, well-organised and with a sense of humour. Other desirable qualifications include language skills, experience changing your local community and a keen interest in real politics.

**You could be employed on a number of projects:** Possibilities include working on the getting marginalized workers a Living wage; working in East London on the CitySafe campaign to tackle violence through rebuilding community; working with migrants and asylum seekers as part of the Strangers into Citizens campaign.

The **2009 Summer Academy** will run for four weeks from **Monday 6th July to Friday 31st July** and will include London Citizens' 2-Day Leadership Training on 10th and 11th July. **You will be paid £8.00 - £10.00 (subject to qualifications) per hour for a 40 hour week including occasional evenings**, and all your travel expenses will be covered. Qualities sought include political awareness; ability to work in a diverse group and on your own initiative; and strong interpersonal and relational skills.
